

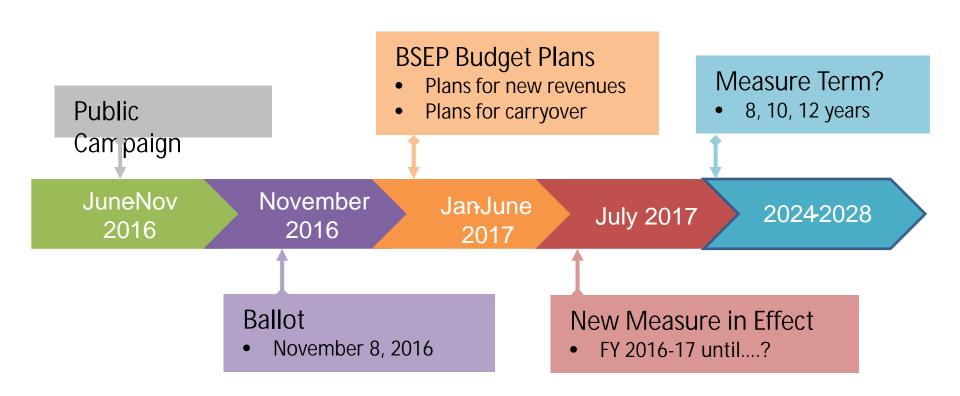

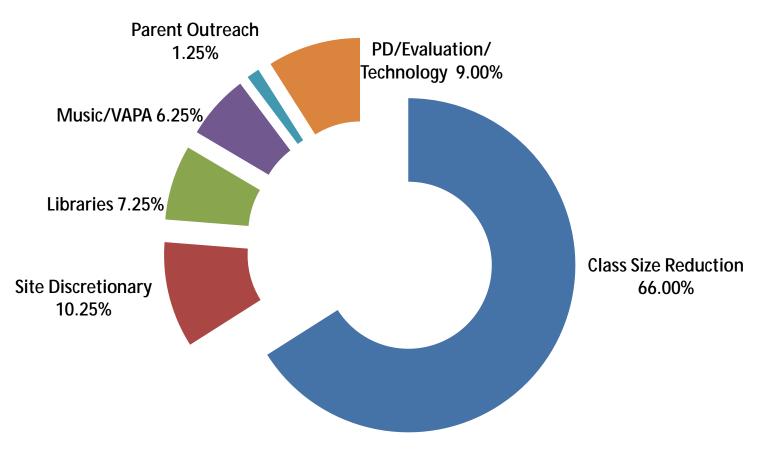

BSEP Measure A of 2006 Revenue Allocation



Nearly \$25 million dollars to BUSD in 20154 over 20% of BUSD total expenditure budget
